**Beneficiaries and benefits.**

Sec. 146.12. Benefits shall be paid from the volunteer firemen's dependents fund to or on behalf of the following persons:

(A) To the widow of a volunteer fireman killed while in the discharge of his duties as a volunteer fireman or who dies from exposure or injury received while in the discharge of such duties, a lump sum award of one thousand dollars, and, in addition, the sum of fifty dollars per month so long as she remains his widow;

(B) To the mother, guardian, or other persons upon whom a child of a volunteer fireman is dependent for chief support, the sum of twelve dollars and fifty cents per month for each dependent child of such volunteer fireman, but not to exceed the total sum of fifty dollars per month. Such payments shall continue until the dependent child is sixteen years old, unless such child is regularly attending a recognized school of secondary educational level, in which case the payments shall continue until the child is eighteen years old or has completed school, whichever date is earlier.

(C) To a volunteer fireman, totally and permanently disabled while in the discharge of his duties as a volunteer fireman, the sum of fifty dollars per month. No payment shall be made to a volunteer fireman under full salary during the time of his disability.
