Sec. 146.12. Benefits shall be paid from the volunteer firemen's dependents fund to or on behalf of the following persons:

- (A) To the widow of a volunteer fireman killed while in the discharge of his duties as a volunteer fireman or who dies from exposure or injury received while in the discharge of such duties, a lump sum award of one thousand dollars, and, in addition, the sum of [fifty] ONE HUNDRED dollars per month so long as she remains his widow;
- (B) To the mother, guardian, or other persons upon whom a child of a volunteer fireman is dependent for chief support, the sum of [twelve] TWENTY-FIVE dollars [and fifty cents] per month for each dependent child of such volunteer fireman [, but not to exceed the total sum of fifty dollars per month]. Such payments shall continue until the dependent child is sixteen years old, unless such child is regularly attending a recognized school of secondary educational level, in which case the payments shall continue until the child is eighteen years old or has completed school, whichever date is earlier.
- (C) To a volunteer fireman, totally and permanently disabled while in the discharge of his duties as a volunteer fireman, the sum of [fifty] ONE HUNDRED dollars per month. No payment shall be made to a volunteer fireman under full salary during the time of his disability.
