Sec. 146.12. Benefits shall be paid from the volunteer fire-
men's FIRE FIGHTERS' dependents fund to or on behalf of the
following persons:

(A) To the widow SURVIVING SPOUSE of a volunteer
FIRE FIGHTER killed while in the discharge of his duties as
DISCHARGING THE DUTIES OF a volunteer fireman FIRE
FIGHTER or who dies from exposure or injury received while in
the discharge of such duties, a lump sum award of one thousand
dollars, and, in addition, the sum of one hundred dollars per month
so long as she remains the widow THE SURVIVING SPOUSE DOES
NOT REMARRY;

(B) To the mother PARENT, guardian, or other persons upon
whom a child of a volunteer fireman FIRE FIGHTER is dependent
for chief support, the sum of twenty-five dollars per month for each
dependent child of such volunteer fireman FIRE FIGHTER. Such
payments shall continue until the dependent child is sixteen years
old, unless such child is regularly attending a recognized school
of secondary educational level, in which case the payments shall
continue until the child is eighteen years old or has completed
school, whichever date is earlier.

(C) To a volunteer fireman FIRE FIGHTER, totally, and
permanently disabled while in the discharge of his duties as DIS-
CHARGING THE DUTIES OF a volunteer fireman FIRE FIGHTER,
the sum of one hundred dollars per month. No payment shall be
made to a volunteer fireman FIRE FIGHTER under full salary
during the time of his disability.
