Sec. 146.14. Claims for benefits payable under section 146.12 of the Revised Code shall be made as follows:

(A) A ~~widow~~ SURVIVING SPOUSE shall file a claim under oath with the volunteer ~~firemen's~~ FIRE FIGHTERS' dependents fund board on a form provided by the board, setting forth the full name of the deceased volunteer ~~fireman~~ FIRE FIGHTER, the name of the fire department or company of which ~~he~~ THE DECEDENT was a member, ~~his~~ THE name and address OF THE SURVIVING SPOUSE, and the names, ages, and addresses of dependent children. ~~She~~ THE SURVIVING SPOUSE shall supply such documentary evidence as the board may reasonably require.

(B) A ~~mother~~ PARENT, guardian, or other person in charge of a dependent child shall file a claim under oath with the board on a form provided by the board, setting forth the full name of the deceased volunteer ~~fireman~~ FIRE FIGHTER, the name of the fire department or company of which ~~he~~ THE FIRE FIGHTER was a member, the name, age, and address of such dependent child. ~~She~~ THE SURVIVING SPOUSE shall supply such documentary evidence as the board may reasonably require.

(C) A totally and permanently disabled volunteer ~~fireman~~ FIRE FIGHTER shall file a claim under oath setting forth the name of the fire department or company of which ~~he~~ THE FIRE FIGHTER was a member, the date of the injury, and satisfactory medical proof that ~~he~~ THE FIRE FIGHTER is totally and permanently disabled.
