Sec. 171.01. There is hereby created the Ohio retirement study commission of fourteen members as follows
(A) Three members of the senate, appointed by the president pro tempore of the senate, not more than two of whom may be members of the same political party ;
(B) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, not more than two of whom may be members of the same political party;
(C) Three members appointed by the governor, WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SEN OF THE SAME POLAN CAL PARTY one of whom shall represent the state and its doy , of whom shall represent nonstate governments and poyees, one of ; one of whom shall represent educational employers and their employees TERMS OF THE EXISTING MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED Terms of office of members appointed by the rovernor shall be for teree years commencing on the first day of July and ending on the hree years, commencing on mern day shall hold office from the date of his appointment until the end shall hold office from the date of his appointment until the end by the governor to fill a vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of the governor to fill a vacancy occurring prior to the expiration office for the remainder of such term. Any member shall continue office for the remainder of such term. Any member shall continue
in office subsequent to the expiration date of his term until his successor takes office, or until a period of sixty days has elapsed whichever occurs first.
(D) Five ex-officio members as follows: the executive director of the public employees retirement system, the executive director of the state teache retirement system, the exceut drecto: of the school emplose rectrent sisstem, the excen and the secretary of the state highway patrol retirement board, who shall be non-voting members.

A vacancy on the commission shall be filied by the person al to make the original appointment for the unexpirei term, in the sume manner as the original appointment

The members of the commission who are appointed from the membership of the sanate and the house of representatives shall serve during their teims as memi,ers of the general assembly and until Cir successors are appointed and qualified, notwithstanding the adjournment of the general assembly of which they are members or the expiation of their terms as members of such general assembly.
