Service credit.

Sec. 3307.31. The state teachers retirement board shall credit a year of service to any teacher who is employed on a full-time basis in a school district for the number of months the regular day schools of such district were or shall be in session in said district within any year, except that credit granted prior to June 5, 1947, shall not be changed thereby to the disadvantage of the member, and shall determine by appropriate rules and regulations how much credit shall be given for parts thereof, and for such other service as is defined as prior service in section 3307.01 of the Revised Code, but in computing such service, or in computing final compensation, it shall credit not more than one year for all service rendered in any year.

Except in cases of retirement on a combined basis, pursuant to section 3307.41 of the Revised Code, service credit for any period shall be credited on the basis of the ratio that contributions to the state teachers retirement system bears to the total contributions in all the state retirement systems.

Section 3. Any member, eligible for any of the retirement allowances or other benefits provided in Chapters 145., 3307., and 3309. of the Revised Code as of June 30, 1959, or July 1, 1959, and who terminated his public service during the month of June, 1959, but did not file an application for retirement, may file, as provided by law, during the month of July, 1959, and shall be eligible for retirement as of June 30, 1959, or July 1, 1959, and such allowances or benefits shall be payable from and after July 1, 1959, and any such member or any member retiring on June 30, 1959, or July 1, 1959, voluntarily or otherwise, shall be eligible for allowances or benefits as computed under the provisions of this act.
