Sec. 3309.22. The treasurer of state shall furnish annually to the school employees retirement board a sworn statement of the amount of the funds in his custody belonging to the school employees retirement system. The records of the board shall be

open to public inspection, except for the following which shall be excluded: The history record as provided for in section 3309.28, and any information identifying by name and address the amount of a monthly allowance or benefit paid to a retirant, beneficiary, or survivor, except with the written authorization of the individual concerned. All medical reports and recommendations required by the system are privileged except that copies of such medical reports or recommendations shall be made available to the member's personal physician, attorney, or authorized agent upon written release received from the member or his agent, or when necessary for the proper administration of the fund, to the board assigned physician.

Any member of the system shall be furnished with a statement of the amount to the credit of his individual account upon written request by such member. The board need not answer more than one such request of a member in any one year.

The board shall furnish the director of the Ohio student loan commission with the information required under division (A) of section 3351.071 of the Revised Code.

WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS AFTER RECEIVING FROM THE DIRECTOR OF HUMAN SERVICES A LIST OF THE NAMES AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS OF RECIPI-ENTS OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 5101.181 OF THE REVISED CODE, THE BOARD SHALL INFORM THE AUDITOR OF STATE OF THE NAME. CUR-RENT OR MOST RECENT EMPLOYER ADDRESS, AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF EACH MEMBER WHOSE NAME AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER ARE THE SAME AS THAT OF A PERSON WHOSE NAME OR SOCIAL SECU-RITY NUMBER WAS SUBMITTED BY THE DIRECTOR. THE BOARD AND ITS EMPLOYEES SHALL, EXCEPT FOR PURPOSES OF FURNISHING THE AUDITOR OF STATE WITH INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION, PRE-SERVE THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF RECIPIENTS OF PUB-LIC ASSISTANCE IN COMPLIANCE WITH DIVISION (A) OF SECTION 5101.181 OF THE REVISED CODE.
