Sec. 3309.43. A member of the school employees retirement system who has ceased to be an employee, and who is also a member of either the public employees retirement system or the state teachers retirement system, or both, may not withdraw his accumulated contributions unless his service credit in the school employees retirement system is less than one year BEFORE RETIREMENT, UNLESS HE ALSO WITHDRAWS HIS CONTRIBUTIONS FROM SUCH OTHER SYSTEMS. The school employees retirement board may waive the annual expense fee where a member is contributing to another state retirement system provided such member is not at the same time contributing to the school employees retirement system.
