Retirement allowances exempt from tax, execution, or garnishment.

Sec. 3309.66. The right of a person to a pension, an annuity, or retirement allowance itself, any optional benefit, any other right accrued or accruing to any persons under sections 3309.01 to 3309.68, inclusive, of the Revised Code, the various funds created by section 3309.60 of the Revised Code and all moneys and investments and income thereof, are hereby exempt from any state tax, including the inheritance tax, any county, municipal, or other local tax, and shall not be subject to execution, garnishment, attachment, the operation of bankruptcy or insolvency laws, or any other process of law whatsoever, and shall be unassignable except as specifically provided in sections 3309.01 to 3309.68, inclusive, of the Revised Code.
