

Sec. 5505.151. ANY MEMBER WHO IS GRANTED DISABILITY LEAVE PURSUANT TO A PROGRAM SPONSORED BY THE STATE, WHEREBY THE MEMBER RECEIVES A PERCENTAGE OF HIS SALARY WHILE ON DISABILITY LEAVE, SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO MAKE CONTRIBUTIONS FOR TIME OFF WHILE ON DISABILITY LEAVE.

THE STATE, AS SPONSOR OF A DISABILITY LEAVE PROGRAM, IS REQUIRED TO MAKE THE PERIODIC EMPLOYEE AND EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS, IN THE AMOUNTS SET PURSUANT TO SECTION 5505.15 OF THE REVISED CODE, FOR MEMBERS GRANTED DISABILITY LEAVE, BASED ON THE EMPLOYEE'S RATE OF PAY IN EFFECT AT THE TIME DISABILITY LEAVE WAS GRANTED.
