Credit for military service prior to September 30, 1948.

Sec. 742.18. A member of the fund who, during periods of national emergency as declared by the president or the congress of the United States, enlisted, was inducted, or accepted a commission in the armed forces of the United States, shall, in computing years of service in a police or fire department, be given full credit for the time served in the armed forces, provided, such member has been honorably discharged from the armed forces on or before September 30, 1948, and has made application for reinstatement in the police or fire department of which he was a member prior to such service, within ninety days from the date of such discharge. (Enacted in Amended House Bill No. 642)
