Municipal police department employee credit for service in fire department.

Sec. 742.23. A member of the fund who is an employee of the police department of a municipal corporation and who has

resigned or has been honorably discharged from membership in the fire department of the same municipal corporation shall, in computing years of service in the police department, be given full credit for time served in such fire department, provided he has paid into the police and firemen's disability and pension fund a sum equal to that which he would have been required to pay, under sections 741.12 and 742.31 of the Revised Code; as a member of such fire department during the years for which service credit is claimed had he been contributing a percentage of his salary to a firemen's relief and pension fund or to the police and firemen's disability and pension fund as provided by such sections during such years.
