## Report of member deductions; transmission of warrants or checks.

Sec. 742.32. Following the date of transfer of the assets of a police relief and pension fund, established under section 741.32 of the Revised Code, or of the assets of a firemen's relief and pension fund, established under section 521.02 or 741.02 of the Revised Code, pursuant to section 742.26 of the Revised Code, the fiscal officer of the employer shall transmit promptly to the secretary of the board of trustees of the police and firemen's disability and pension fund a report of member deductions at such intervals and in such form as the board requires. Such reports shall show all deductions for the police and firemen's disability and pension fund made pursuant to section 742.31 of the Revised Code and shall be accompanied by warrants or checks covering the total of such deductions. Separate warrants or checks shall be so transmitted for that portion of such deductions made from the salaries of members of the police department and for that portion of deductions from the salaries of members of the fire department. The secretary of the board, after making a record of all such receipts and crediting each member's individual account with the amount deducted from his salary, shall deposit them with the treasurer of state for use as provided by sections 742.01 to 742.49, inclusive, of the Revised Code. Where an employer fails or refuses to deduct contributions for any member and transmit such amounts to the

police and firemen's disability and pension fund, the board may make a determination of the employee's liability for contributions and certify to the employer the amounts due for collection in the same manner and subject to the same penalties as payments due the employer's contribution funds.
