Sec. 742.361. On or before the first day of August in 1980 and each ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF August IN EACH YEAR thereafter, the board of trustees of the police and firemen's disability and pension fund shall certify to the treasurer of state the amount required to be paid IN THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR under divisions (D), (E), (F), and (H)(2), (3), and (4) of section 742.37 and by sections 742.374, 742.377, and 742.3710 of the Revised Code. Upon receipt of such certification, the treasurer of state shall pay to the fund the amount certified.

SECTION 19. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare. The necessity lies in the immediate need for the rehabilitation, construction, and completion of facilities at the mental institutions and correctional institutions, classroom and laboratory facilities at the educational institutions, and office facilities and space for other departments and agencies. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect.
