Sec. 742.3721. IN LIEU OF RECEIVING A BENEFIT PURSUANT TO DIVISION (C)(3), (4), OR (5) OF SECTION 742.37 OF THE REVISED CODE FOR PARTIAL DISABILITY, A MEMBER OF THE POLICE AND FIREMEN'S DISABILITY AND PENSION FUND MAY REQUEST THAT THE EMPLOYING POLICE OR FIRE DEPARTMENT EMPLOY THE MEMBER IN ANOTHER POSITION WITH DUTIES THE MEMBER IS PHYSICALLY AND MENTALLY CAPABLE OF PERFORMING. NOTWITHSTANDING CHAPTER 124. OF THE REVISED CODE OR MUNICIPAL CIVIL SERVICE REQUIREMENTS, THE POLICE OR FIRE DEPARTMENT MAY EMPLOY THE MEMBER IN ANY POSITION WITH DUTIES THE MEMBER IS PHYSICALLY AND MENTALLY CAPABLE OF PERFORMING.

SECTION 6. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is that the recommendations of the Ohio Retirement Study Commission issued in its annual report of December 14, 1994, on the Police and Firemen's Disability and Pension Fund need immediate implementation in order to ensure the proper financing of the benefits provided by the Fund. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect.
