Credit for armed forces service.

Sec. 145.30. Upon re-employment in the public service and completing one year of service credit as covered by the public employees retirement system, the state teachers retirement system, or the state school employees retirement system, within two years after an honorable discharge, and presentation of an honorable discharge or certificate of service and subject to such rules and regulations as are adopted by the retirement board, any member of the public employees retirement system who maintained his membership in the public employees retirement system as provided by section 145.41 of the Revised Code, and who was or is out of active service as a public employee by reason of having become a member of the armed forces of the United States on active duty or service shall have such military service, not in excess of ten years, considered as the equivalent of prior service. "Armed forces" of the United States includes army, navy, air force, marine corps, coast guard, auxiliary corps as established by congress, army nurse corps, navy nurse corps, and such other service as may be designated by congress as included therein. ***
