

erty, to condition eligibility for filing a consolidated franchise tax return upon each of the combining corporation's deriving income other than dividend income from sources within Ohio, and to extend the Weatherization Policy Advisory Committee until December 31, 1981, to allow dealers in motor vehicle fuel who blend ethanol or methane with unleaded gasoline a tax credit, to extend the deadline for certain Medicaid nursing home demonstration projects from July 1, 1981 to October 31, 1981, and to clarify changes in the law that were made by Am. Sub. H.B. 102 of the 114th General Assembly.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:*

SECTION 1. That sections 742.36, 742.362, 5733.052, 5735.051, 5735.06, 5735.13, 5735.14, 5735.141, 5735.142, 5735.145, and 5735.17 be amended and sections 145.3210, 742.3712, 3307.409, 3309.3710, 4981.11, 4981.12, and 5505.173 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 145.3210. (A) EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1981, EACH PERSON ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN ALLOWANCE, PENSION, OR BENEFIT PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 145.33, 145.34, 145.36, 145.37, DIVISION (A) OF SECTION 145.45, AND SECTION 145.46 OF THE REVISED CODE, THAT WAS BASED UPON AN AWARD MADE EFFECTIVE BEFORE JULY 1, 1974, SHALL HAVE HIS MONTHLY ALLOWANCE, PENSION, OR BENEFIT INCREASED BY FIVE PER CENT, EXCEPT THAT THE TWELVE-MONTH SUM OF SUCH INCREASES SHALL NOT EXCEED FIVE PER CENT OF THE FIRST FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS OF THE ANNUAL ALLOWANCE, PENSION, OR BENEFIT.

(B) EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1981, EACH PERSON RECEIVING OR QUALIFIED TO RECEIVE A BENEFIT, PURSUANT TO DIVISION (B) OF SECTION 145.45 OF THE REVISED CODE, THAT WAS EFFECTIVE ON AND AFTER JUNE 14, 1951, THROUGH AUGUST 26, 1970, SHALL RECEIVE AN INCREASE IN SUCH BENEFIT OF FIVE PER CENT.

(C) THE INCREASES PROVIDED IN DIVISIONS (A) AND (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE APPLIED TO THE BENEFIT PAYABLE ON AND AFTER JULY 1, 1981.

(D) THE INCREASE IN THE MONTHLY ALLOWANCE, PENSION, OR BENEFIT PROVIDED IN DIVISIONS (A) AND (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE CALCULATION OF ADDITIONAL BENEFITS TO RECIPIENTS UNDER SECTION 145.323 OF THE REVISED CODE.

(E) THE BENEFITS PROVIDED IN DIVISIONS (A) AND (B) OF THIS SECTION ARE A CONTINUATION OF THOSE FIRST PROVIDED IN AM. SUB. H.B. 204 AS PASSED BY THE 113TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

(F) ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF AUGUST, 1982, AND ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF AUGUST IN EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT BOARD SHALL CERTIFY TO THE TREASURER OF STATE THE AMOUNT NEEDED TO PAY THE COST OF THE ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION FOR THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR. UPON RECEIPT OF THESE CERTIFICATIONS, THE TREASURER OF STATE SHALL PAY THE AMOUNT CERTIFIED.

Sec. 742.36. The treasurer of state shall pay in ~~June, 1980~~ AUGUST, 1981 and each ~~June~~ AUGUST thereafter from appropriations made for such purposes to the police and firemen's disability and pension fund one million two hundred thousand dollars which shall be known as the "state contribution." Upon receipt of such state contribution, the board of trustees of the police and firemen's pension fund shall place the state contribution in the guarantee fund to be distributed in accordance with division (G) of section 742.38 of the Revised Code.

Sec. 742.362. In lieu of an employer contribution to pay part of the cost of the benefits provided under section 742.52 of the Revised Code, the treasurer of state shall make a payment to the police and firemen's disability and pension fund in ~~June, 1980~~ AUGUST, 1981 and each ~~June~~ AUGUST thereafter from appropriations made for the purpose by the general assembly.

Sec. 742.3712. (A) EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1981, EACH PERSON ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN AGE AND SERVICE OR DISABILITY PENSION, ALLOWANCE, OR BENEFIT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 742. OF THE REVISED CODE THAT WAS BASED UPON AN AWARD MADE EFFECTIVE BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1974, SHALL HAVE HIS MONTHLY PENSION INCREASED BY FIVE PER CENT, EXCEPT THAT THE TWELVE-MONTH SUM OF SUCH INCREASE SHALL NOT EXCEED FIVE PER CENT OF THE FIRST FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS OF THE ANNUAL PENSION ALLOWANCE OR BENEFIT.
