

**Retirant's allowance and subsequent employment.**

Sec. 145.382. A former member receiving a retirement allowance, other than a disability allowance, from the public employees retirement system, and hereafter referred to as a retirant, may be employed, notwithstanding sections 145.381 and 145.46 of the Revised Code, if his later employment has been in a position authorized by section 101.27, 101.30, 121.03 or 121.04 of the Revised Code, and shall be entitled to a retirement allowance based on his total contributions and service credit accrued during all service as a public employee. Upon his later retirement the retirant may elect to receive retirement benefits based upon his original service and his service after re-entering public service by selecting any of the optional benefit plans specified in section 145.46 of the Revised Code.
