Sec. 171.02. The Ohio retirement study commission shall hold its first meeting at the call of the speaker of the house of representatives not later than July 15, 1968. Meetings thereafter shall be called in such manner and at such times as prescribed by rules adopted by the commission. A majority of the commission constitutes a quorum and no action shall be taken by the commission unless approved by at least six members. At its first meeting, the commission shall organize by selecting a chairman, a vice-chairman, and such other officers as it deems necessary. The commission shall adopt rules for the conduct of its business and the election of its officers, and shall establish an office in Columbus. Each member of the commission, before entering on his official duties shall take and subscribe to an oath of office, to uphold the constitution and laws of the United States and this state and to perform the duties of his office honestly, faithfully, and impartially. Members of the commission shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
