Sec. 171.02. Meetings of the Ohio retirement study commission COUNCIL shall be called in such manner and at such times as prescribed by rules adopted by the commission COUNCIL. A majority of the commission COUNCIL constitutes a quorum and no action shall be taken by the commission COUNCIL unless approved by at least five voting members. The commission COUNCIL shall organize by selecting a chairman CHAIRPERSON, vice-chairman VICE-CHAIRPERSON, and such other officers as it deems necessary. The commission COUNCIL shall adopt rules for the conduct of its business and the election of its officers, and shall establish an office in Columbus. Each member of the commission COUN CIL, before entering upon his THE MEMBER'S official duties shall take and subscribe to an oath of office, to uphold the constitution and laws of the united states UNITED STATES and this state and to perform the duties of his THE office honestly, faithfully, and impartially. Members of the commission COUNCIL shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
