Sec. 3307.06. [Biennielly] ANNUALLY on the first Monday of May [of the odd-numbered years], one teacher; member of the state teachers retirement system, shall be elected by ballot to membership on the state teachers retirement board to serve four years, beginning on the first day of September following the election. Vacancies occurring in the terms of teacher members of the board shall be filled by the remaining members of the board by election for the unexpired terms. Teacher members of the board who fail to attend the meetings of the board for four months or longer, without being excused, shall be considered as having resigned and successors shall be elected for their unexpired terms.

Section 4. One hundred ten days after the effective date of this act, the two additional teacher members to be elected under section 3307.06 of the Revised Code shall be elected by ballot to serve as follows: one for a term beginning September 1, 1973, and ending August 31, 1974, and one for a term beginning September 1, 1973, and ending August 31, 1976. Each teacher member's petition for election to a term under this section shall state the term for which he is a candidate, and no person shall be a candidate for more than one teacher member position. The candidate receiving the greatest number of votes for each teacher member position shall be elected to the position.

This act shall not affect the terms of teacher members presently holding office.
