Sec. 3307.21. The treasurer of state shall furnish annually to the state teachers retirement board a sworn statement of the amount of the funds in his custody belonging to the state teachers retirement system.

The records of the board shall be open to public inspection, except for the following which shall be excluded: the [history record as] PERSONAL RECORDS provided for in section 3307.29 of the Revised Code and all medical reports and recommendations provided for in sections 3307.42, 3307.44, and [division (B) (3) and (4) of

section] 3307.49 of the Revised Code, provided, that with the recommendation of the medical representative of the board, copies of such medical reports or recommendations may be made available to the personal physician of the member when [such] THE release is deemed to be in the best interest of the member.

Any member of the system shall be furnished with a statement of the amount to the credit of his individual account upon written request by [such] THE member. The board need not answer more than one [such] request of a member in any one year.
