Membership of retirement system.

Sec. 3307.22. The membership of the state teachers retirement system shall consist of :

(A) All teachers in service on September 1, 1920, except teachers who have filed with their employer a statement in writing requesting exemption from membership or teachers who are excluded by sections 3307.01 to *** 3307.73, inclusive, of the Revised Code;

(B) All teachers who became teachers or who were reappointed as teachers after September 1, 1920, except teachers who are excluded by such sections;

(C) The teachers and faculty members in any school or college or other institution supported in whole or in part by the state or any subdivision thereof and wholly controlled and managed by the state or any subdivision thereof shall become members on the same terms as the teachers in the public schools, provided the board of trustees or other managing body of such school, college, or other institution, *** shall agree by formal resolution *** to accept all the requirements and obligations imposed by such sections upon employers of members. Any institution which comes into existence as such shall have ninety days in which to accept said requirements and obligations. A certified copy of said resolution shall be filed with the state teachers retirement board. When such resolution is adopted and a copy of it filed with the state teachers retirement board, it shall not later be subject to rescindment or abrogation. Service in such schools, colleges, or other institutions shall be then considered in every way the same as service in the public schools:

(D) All other teachers who become contributors under sections 3307.01 to *** 3307.73, inclusive, of the Revised Code.
