Sec. 3307.29. Each teacher, upon becoming a member, shall file a detailed statement of all his previous service as a teacher and of such other service as comes under [sections 3307.01 to 3307.72, inclusive, of the Revised Code] THIS CHAPTER, and shall furnish such other facts as the state teachers retirement board requires for the proper operation of the state teachers retirement system. If a teacher fails to file the required membership record within ninety days after becoming a contributor, the secretary shall so advise his employer who shall thereafter withhold all salary payments to such teacher until such record is filed with the state teachers retirement board. [Such personal records and the personal records of the beneficiaries are confidential and are not subject to section 3307.21 of the Revised Code.]
