Right of denial of membership to certain classes of teachers.

Sec. 3307.27. The state teachers retirement board may deny the right to become members to any class of teachers whose compensation is *** partly paid by the state, or who are not serving on a per annum basis, or who are on a temporary basis, or who are not required to have a teacher's certificate, and it may also make optional with teachers in any such class their individual entrance into membership.

The state teachers retirement board may at any time deny membership to any teacher whose compensation, though disbursed by an employer, is reimbursed to the employer, in whole or in part, from other than public funds.
