ANY COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY TEACHER EMPLOYED AFTER JUNE 28, 1978 WHO TEACHES NOT MORE THAN AN ACCUMULATED TOTAL OF FIVE ACADEMIC QUARTER HOURS OR THREE ACADEMIC SEMESTER HOURS PER ACADEMIC TERM SHALL BE EXEMPTED FROM MEMBERSHIP IN THE STATE TEACHERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM IF, PRIOR TO JANUARY 1, 1980 OR WITHIN THE FIRST MONTH AFTER BEING EMPLOYED AS A PART-TIME TEACHER, HE FILES WITH THE SYSTEM AND THE COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, IN SUCH FORM AS THE STATE TEACHERS RETIREMENT BOARD PRESCRIBES, A WRITTEN APPLICATION OF EXEMPTION. THE EXEMPTION SHALL BE IRREVOCABLE WHILE THE PERSON CONTINUES TO BE EMPLOYED AS A PART-TIME COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY TEACHER, AND THE TEACHER SHALL BE BARRED FOREVER FROM CLAIMING OR PURCHASING MEMBERSHIP RIGHTS OR CREDIT FOR ANY PERIOD COVERED BY THE EXEMPTION.
