Sec. 3307.741. THE STATE TEACHERS RETIREMENT BOARD MAY ESTABLISH A PROGRAM UNDER WHICH MEMBERS, AND EMPLOYERS ON BEHALF OF MEMBERS, ARE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN CONTRACTS FOR LONG-TERM HEALTH CARE BENEFITS, ENTERED INTO BY THE BOARD UNDER DIVISION (A) OF SECTION 3307.74 OF THE REVISED CODE. PARTICIPATION MAY INCLUDE THE MEMBER'S DEPENDENTS AND FAMILY MEMBERS. IF THE BOARD ESTABLISHES SUCH A PROGRAM IT SHALL ADOPT RULES IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 111.15 OF THE REVISED CODE GOVERNING THE PROGRAM.

IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER MATTER CONSIDERED RELEVANT BY THE BOARD, RULES ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL SPECIFY CONDITIONS EMPLOYERS MUST MEET FOR MEMBERS IN THEIR EMPLOY TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM AND CONDITIONS MEMBERS AND THEIR DEPENDENTS AND FAMILY MEMBERS MUST MEET TO BE ELIGIBLE.

THE BOARD SHALL ALSO ESTABLISH BY RULE METHODS OF PAYMENT FOR PARTICIPATION UNDER THIS SECTION, WHICH MAY INCLUDE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PAYROLL DEDUCTION PLAN UNDER SECTION 3307.281 OF THE REVISED CODE OR ANY OTHER METHOD OF PAYMENT CONSIDERED APPROPRIATE BY THE BOARD.
