Sec. 3307.712. (A) Any person who is receiving, ~~or becomes eligible to receive,~~ an allowance, benefit, or any increase under ~~the provisions of Chapter 3307. of the Revised Code,~~ THIS CHAPTER may, at any time, waive his rights thereto, or to a portion thereof, by filing a written notice of waiver with the state teachers retirement board. ~~Such~~ EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN DIVISION (B) OF THIS SECTION, SUCH waiver shall remain in effect until the first day of the month following his death or the filing of his written cancellation of such waiver with the state teachers retirement board. Any amount so waived shall forever be forfeited.

(B) IF A BENEFICIARY WAIVES IN WRITING ALL CLAIM TO ANY BENEFITS UNDER THIS CHAPTER PRIOR TO RECEIPT OF THE FIRST BENEFIT, THE WAIVER SHALL PUT INTO EFFECT THE SUCCESSION OF BENEFICIARIES AS PROVIDED IN DIVISION (C) OF SECTION 3307.48 OF THE REVISED CODE AND SHALL BE IRREVOCABLE.
