Sec. 3307.52. DURING THE PERIOD FROM JULY 1, 1975, TO JUNE 30, 1978, ANY MEMBER WHO PREVIOUSLY WAS GRANTED A LEAVE OF ABSENCE BECAUSE OF PERSONAL ILLNESS OR INJURY, OR PURSUANT TO SECTION 3319.13 OR 3319.131 OF THE REVISED CODE, OR SUCH OTHER REASON APPROVED BY THE STATE TEACHERS RETIREMENT BOARD, AND WHO HAS NOT MADE CONTRIBUTION FOR SUCH ABSENCE MAY DO SO PRIOR TO JUNE 30, 1978, UNDER RULES ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD. TO OBTAIN CREDIT FOR SUCH LEAVE THE TEACHERS MUST DEPOSIT AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO EIGHT PER CENT OF CURRENT SALARY TOGETHER WITH INTEREST COMPOUNDED ANNUALLY AT A RATE ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD FROM THE DATE THE LEAVE TERMINATED TO THE DATE OF PAYMENT. NO MORE THAN TWO YEARS OF SERVICE CREDIT MAY BE SECURED UNDER TERMS OF THIS SECTION.
