Sec. 3307.38. Any member who has five years of service credit and has attained age sixty, or who has twenty-five years of service credit and has attained age fifty-five, or who has thirty-five years of service credit shall be granted service retirement after filing with the state teachers retirement board a completed application on a form approved by the board.

Service retirement shall be effective [for contributing members] on the first [day] of [February, July, August, and September, except as provided in sections 3307.41 and 3307.43 of the Revised Code. A member who has not contributed during the year may retire effective the first day of any month, and a member who has not contributed after the first day of February may retire the first day of any month thereafter] THE MONTH FOLLOWING THE DATE OF APPLICATION OR THE FIRST OF THE MONTH FOLLOWING THE LAST DAY FOR WHICH COMPENSATION WAS PAID, WHICH-EVER IS LATER.

The service retirement benefit shall be the greater of the benefits provided in divisions (A) and (B) of this section.

(A) The annual single lifetime benefit of a member who has three or more years of total service credit within the ten years immediately prior to retirement, or who is receiving a disability retirement benefit, shall be the greater of the amounts determined by his total [Ohio] service credit multiplied by (a) [eighty two] EIGHTY-SIX dollars, or by (b) [one and ninety hundredtis] TWO per cent of his final average salary, adjusted by the greater per cent shown in the following schedule opposite his attained age or Ohio service credit.

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The annual single lifetime benefit payable under this division, shall not exceed eighty per cent of the final average salary, except that UNTIL SEPTEMBER 1. 1976, such limitation shall be further adjusted by the factors of attained age or years of service to provide the highest percentage as determined by the following schedule:

Any member who was an elective official of the state or any political subdivision thereof in a position for which an annual salary was paid shall be entitled to have his retirement benefit computed as provided in this division, notwithstanding the provision requiring three or more years of total service credit within the ten years immediately prior to retirement.

- (B) The annual single lifetime benefit of a member shall be the sum of the following amounts:
- (1) An annuity with a reserve equal to the member's accumulated contributions.
 - (2) A pension equal to the amount in paragraph (1) above.
- (3) An additional pension of forty dollars annually multiplied by the number of years of prior and military service credit, except years of credit purchased under section 3307.021 of the Revised Code.
- (4) An additional basic annual pension of one hundred eighty dollars, provided the member had ten or more years of Ohio service credit as of October 1, 1956, except that such additional basic annual pension shall not exceed the sum of the annual benefits provided by paragraphs (1), (2), and (3) of this division.

Section 3. Notwithstanding Chapters 145., 3307., and 3309. of the Revised Code, on the effective date of this act, the public employees retirement board, the state teachers retirement board, and the school employees retirement board shall recalculate the amount of all monthly benefits elected between June 29, 1971, and the effective date of this act pursuant to former sections 145.33, 145.34, 145.36, division (A) of section 145.45, sections 3307.38, 3307.43, division (A) of section 3307.49 and sections 3309.36, 3309.38, 3309.40, and division (A) of section 3309.45 of the Revised Code, as if this act had been in effect on June 30, 1971. Any such benefit payments made after the effective date of this act shall be for the amount calculated in accordance with this section, unless such recalculation would provide a decrease in benefits, in which case the boards shall continue to pay the benefit as elected and calculated prior to the effective date of this act.
