

**Statement of prior service.**

Sec. 3309.28. Each employee, upon becoming a member, shall file a detailed statement showing sex, title, compensation, duties, date of birth, and all his prior service as an employee or such other service as comes under sections 3309.01 to 3309.68, inclusive, of the Revised Code, and shall furnish such other facts as the school employees retirement board requires for the proper operation of the school employees retirement system. If *\*\*\* a member* fails to file the required *\*\*\** record within thirty days after becoming a contributor, the secretary shall so advise his employer who shall thereafter withhold all salary payments to such *\*\*\* member* until such record is filed with the school employees retirement board.

SECTION 3. Any member, eligible for any of the retirement allowances or other benefits provided in Chapters 145., 3307., and 3309. of the Revised Code as of June 30, 1959, or July 1, 1959, and who terminated his public service during the month of June, 1959, but did not file an application for retirement, may file, as provided by law, during the month of July, 1959, and shall be eligible for retirement as of June 30, 1959, or July 1, 1959, and such allowances or benefits shall be payable from and after July 1, 1959, and any such member or any member retiring on June 30, 1959, or July 1, 1959, voluntarily or otherwise, shall be eligible for allowances or benefits as computed under the provisions of this act.
