## Sec. 3309.31 (7896-95). Additional credit may be claimed.

Any member, in addition to service as an \*\*\* employee, may claim credit for similar service as an \*\*\* employee in the public schools, in state universities, state normal schools, and other state institutions of a character similar to the state supported schools \*\*\* in which membership in the school employees retirement system is allowed, of another state of the United States, or of any territory or possession of the United States, and such service shall be treated by the school employees retirement board as prior service in the state \*\*\* provided that the \*\*\* employee shall pay into the employers' accumulation fund an amount equal to the full additional liability assumed by such fund on account of the crediting of such years of service rendered outside of the state. \*\*\* In the same manner any member may claim credit for service rendered subsequent to September \*\*\* 1, 1937, as an \*\*\* employee of an employer who comes within the provision of any other Ohio state retirement system \*\*\* or for similar service rendered at any time in another state of the United States or of any territory or possession thereof, providing \*\*\* credit cannot be purchased for service rendered in \*\*\* this state for which credit or benefits have been received in any other Ohio state retirement system \*\*\* or for credit that was forfeited by withdrawal of contributions. The \*\*\* board shall have final authority to determine and fix the amount that shall be paid for such service either inside or outside of the state by any member who desires to claim such service and make such payment. Such payment, together with regular interest compounded annually, shall be refunded in the event of the death or withdrawal from service of the member prior to retirement under the same conditions and in the same manner as refunds are made from the \*\*\* employees' savings fund \*\*\*.
