**Sec. 3309.34 (7896-99). Application for retirement to be filed with board; retired member ineligible for employment.**

Any \*\*\* employee, except a new entrant with less than five years of service, who has attained sixty years of age may retire, if a member, by filing with the *school employees* retirement board an application for retirement.

The filing of such application shall retire such member as of the end of the quarter of the calendar year then current. An employer may terminate the employment of a member at the end of the year in which *the age of seventy* is attained or thereafter at the end of any quarter of the year.

Any person who accepts a retirement allowance or who is compelled to retire and elects to withdraw his accumulated contributions in lieu of accepting a retirement allowance under \*\*\* *section 3309.36 or 3309.38 of the Revised Code* shall be ineligible for regular employment in any capacity which comes under \*\*\* *sections 3309.01 to 3309.68, inclusive, of the Revised Code*, and \*\*\* *no employer* \*\*\* shall employ such person. If a person receiving a retirement allowance from \*\*\* *the school employees retirement system* is regularly employed in a school district, the total amount of the allowance paid during the period of such employment shall be certified by the secretary of the *school employees retirement board* to the superintendent of public instruction who shall order such amount paid from the state public school fund to the *school employees retirement system* from any amount due the school district in which such person was employed.
