

Application for retirement to be filed with board; retired member ineligible for employment.

Sec. 3309.34 (7896-99). Any employee, except a new entrant with less than five years of service, who has attained sixty years of age may retire, if a member, by filing with the school employees retirement board an application for retirement.

The filing of such application shall retire such member as of the end of the quarter of the calendar year then current. An employer may terminate the employment of a member at the end of the year in which the age of seventy is attained or thereafter at the end of any quarter of the year.

Any person who accepts a retirement allowance *** shall be ineligible for regular employment in *** *an office or position* which comes under sections 3309.01 to 3309.68, inclusive, of the Revised Code, and no employer shall employ such person. *** *Where a person is receiving a retirement allowance such allowance shall not be paid during the period the person holds any remunerative office or position in any federal, state, county, or local government for which compensation in excess of six hundred dollars per year is received.*
