## Sec. 5505.18 (1185-18). Permanent disability.

Any member of the state highway patrol pension system who has received a permanent total disability shall be eligible for pension upon application to the superintendent of the state highway patrol and approval

of the state highway patrol pension board. In event of disability the member shall first be examined by a physician selected by the \*\*\* board and a physician selected by the disabled member, and such two physicians shall select a disinterested third physician. If such medical examination \*\*\* shows that \*\*\* the member is physically or mentally incapacitated for the performance of duty and ought to be retired, the examining physicians shall so report and the\*\*\* board shall retire \*\*\* such member for disability, forthwith.

Any member placed on disability pension shall be subject to reexamination by physicians appointed by the \*\*\* board at such times as the \*\*\* board deems necessary. A member who has been on disability pension, and who has been physically examined and found capable of performing his duties, shall be restored to the rank \*\*\* which he held at the time he was pensioned, and all previous rights shall be restored, including his civil service status.
