

Sec. 742.05. Any vacancy occurring in the term of a member of the board of trustees of the police and firemen's disability and pension fund who is the fiscal officer of a municipal corporation shall be filled by appointment by the governor for the unexpired term of such member.

Any vacancy occurring in the term of an EMPLOYEE member of the board who is an employee of a police or fire department shall be filled by the remaining EMPLOYEE members AND THE RETIRANT MEMBER of the board who are employees of a police or fire department for the unexpired term of such member.

ANY VACANCY OCCURRING IN THE TERM OF THE RETIRANT MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL BE FILLED BY THE EMPLOYEE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD FOR THE UNEXPIRED TERM.

When a member of the board who is the fiscal officer of a municipal corporation ceases to be a fiscal officer of a

When a IF AN EMPLOYEE member of the board who is an employee of a police or fire department of a municipal corporation or a fire department of a township ceases to be an employee of a police or fire department of a municipal corporation or a fire department of a township, a vacancy shall exist.

IF AS A RESULT OF CHANGED CIRCUMSTANCES THE RETIRANT MEMBER NO LONGER QUALIFIES FOR MEMBERSHIP ON THE BOARD AS THE RETIRANT MEMBER, A VACANCY SHALL EXIST.

Any EMPLOYEE OR RETIRANT MEMBER OF THE BOARD OR member of the board who is the fiscal officer of a municipal corporation or an employee of a police or fire department of a municipal corporation or a fire department of a township who fails to attend three consecutive meetings of the board, without valid excuse, shall be considered as having resigned from the board and the board shall declare his office vacated and as of the date of the adoption of a proper resolution a vacancy shall exist.

SECTION 3. The first election for the fifth employee member of the Board of Trustees of the Police and Firemen's Disability and Pension Fund shall be for an employee member to represent firefighters and shall be held in May, 1983. Nominating petitions for the election shall be filed in the office of the Board not later than four p.m. on the first Monday in April, 1983, and ballots shall be mailed to members eligible to vote on or before the first Monday in May, 1983.

The first election for the retiree member of the Board shall be for a retiree member to represent police retirees and shall be held in May, 1983. Nominating petitions for the election shall be filed in the office of the Board not later than four p.m. on the first Monday in April, 1983, and ballots shall be mailed to persons eligible to vote on or before the first Monday in May, 1983.
