

Sec. 742.10. The board of trustees of the police and firemen's disability and pension fund may sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, contract and be contracted with, employ and fix the compensation of a secretary and such technical, clerical, and administrative employees and assistants, and may make all necessary rules and regulations as it deems necessary for the proper administration and management of the police and fireman's disability and pension fund in accordance with sections 742.01 to 742.49, inclusive, of the Revised Code. THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL PRESCRIBE PROCEDURES FOR THE ADOPTION OF RULES AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS CHAPTER, CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISION OF SECTION 111.15 OF THE REVISED CODE UNDER WHICH ALL RULES SHALL BE FILED IN ORDER TO BE EFFECTIVE. SUCH PROCEDURES SHALL ESTABLISH METHODS BY WHICH NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES ARE GIVEN TO INTERESTED PARTIES AND RULES ADOPTED BY THE BOARD PUBLISHED AND OTHERWISE MADE AVAILABLE.

ALL RULES ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER, PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, SHALL BE PUBLISHED AND MADE AVAILABLE TO INTERESTED PARTIES BY JANUARY 1, 1977.
