

Filing of statements by board.

Sec. 742.16. On or before February 1, 1966, the board of trustees of each police relief and pension fund, established under section 741.32 of the Revised Code, and the board of trustees of each firemen's relief and pension fund, established under section 741.02 of the Revised Code, and the board of trustees of each firemen's relief and pension fund, established under section 521.02 of the Revised Code, shall file with the board of trustees of the police and firemen's disability and pension fund a statement setting forth:

(1) Name, address, age, annual compensation, and service credit of each employee who is a member of such fund and whether

such employee is entitled to receive pensions and benefits from such fund in accordance with the rules of such fund in force on April 1, 1947, or under sections 521.11, 741.18, or 741.49 of the Revised Code;

(2) The total amount which has been deducted from the salary of each employee and credited to such fund;

(3) Name, address, age, monthly amount, and type of benefit or pension being paid to each person who is receiving a pension or benefit from such fund;

(4) Such other information as the board of trustees of the police and firemen's disability and pension fund may request.

Such statement shall be made on forms prescribed and prepared by the board of trustees of the police and firemen's disability and pension fund.

Each such statement shall be accompanied by a certificate of the treasurer of the municipal corporation or the township clerk, who is the custodian of such fund, as to the assets of such fund in his possession on December 31, 1965, and a certified copy of the rules and regulations of such fund, governing the granting of benefits and pensions from such fund, in force on April 1, 1947.
