Sec. 742.20. A member of the fund who is an employee of the A police department of a municipal corporation who, at any time after June 1, 1950, enlisted, was inducted, or accepted a commission in the armed forces of the United States shall, in computing years of service in the SUCH police department of such municipal corporation, be given full credit for such time served in the armed forces, provided, such person has been honorably discharged or separated under honorable conditions from the armed forces on or before June 1, 1955, and has made application for reinstatement in such police department within ninety days from the date of such discharge or separation.

SECTION 5. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is that there are persons who would be eligible to retire under the Public Employees, School Employees, or State Teachers Retirement System as soon as the purchase of service credit the act authorizes becomes effective. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect.
