Sec. 742.361. On or before the first day of August in 1980
and ~~each~~ ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF August IN
EACH YEAR thereafter, the board of trustees of the police and
firemen's disability and pension fund shall certify to the trea-
surer of state the amount required to be paid IN THE PRE-
CEDING FISCAL YEAR under divisions (D), (E), (F), and (H)(2),
(3), and (4) of section 742.37 and by sections 742.374, 742.377, and
742.3710 of the Revised Code. Upon receipt of such certification,
the treasurer of state shall pay to the fund the amount certified.

Sec. 3307.404. On and after ~~the effective date of this section~~
DECEMBER 31, 1971, all persons who retired and were eligible
to receive a pension that was payable prior to July 1, 1968, pur-
suant to section 3307.38 or 3307.43 of the Revised Code, or in the
event of the death of such persons, the person designated by the
deceased to receive payments under section 3307.50 of the
Revised Code, shall receive an additional monthly payment of
two dollars for each year between the member's effective date of
retirement or disability and ~~the effective date of this section~~
DECEMBER 31, 1971, or an additional fifty dollars, whichever
is less. ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF AUGUST IN
1980 AND ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF AUGUST IN

RETIREMENT BOARD SHALL CERTIFY TO THE TREA-
