Ladies and Gentlemen:

<u>Submitted in this report</u> are the results of the <u>annual actuarial valuation</u> of the Retirement System's liabilities <u>for retirement allowances being paid</u> retirants and beneficiaries as of <u>June 30, 1973</u>.

The extensive statistical data required to make the valuation was furnished by your Executive Director and his Staff in November, using computer equipment.

The interest rate used in making the valuation was 4.5% per annum, compounded annually.

The mortality table used in making the valuation was the 1960 Group Annuity Mortality Table, set back no years for men and set back 5 years for women (please see Appendix Schedule 17). This assumption is unchanged from a year ago.

COMMENT

Based upon the results of the June 30, 1973 valuation, the mortality table in use appears to be a reasonable measure of mortality being experienced among retirants and beneficiaries. There follows the computed changes in the "Ratio of Ledger Balance to Liabilities" in each retired life fund.

etirants and beneficiaries receiving benefits from the Annuity and Pension Reserve und as of June 30, 1973 totaled 38,940, involving monthly retirement allowances of 6,890,582.

Included in this number were 122 retirants now reemployed whose monthly retireent allowances of \$15,587 have been suspended for their periods of reemployment.

ost of living pension increments being paid to present retirants and beneficiaries otaled \$983,587 monthly.

he ledger balance in the Annuity and Pension Reserve Fund was reported to be 870,691,809 (including unexpended cost of living balance of \$989,362) net of all djusting transfers made following June 30.

he computed liabilities of the Annuity and Pension Reserve Fund totaled \$831,421,128, hich amount represents the lump sum present value of future retirement allowance ayments from this fund to present retirants and beneficiaries.
